1) JAFFAR BIN MAMAT (Ex-employee)

En. Jaafar Bin Mamat was a Senior Operator at Dovechem Terminals S/B and he had worked here for 12 years starting from 1st June 1992 until 16th June 2004. He started as a general worker in 1992 and was later promoted to Operator in 1997. As he was a diligent and responsible worker, he was further promoted to Senior Operator in 2003. He married in 1997. On the 18th June 2004, he succumbed to pneumonia and passed away leaving behind his wife and 4 young children.

The Company donated RM2,500 while the collection from staff amounted to RM811. These contributions were then handed to the family of the late En. Jaafar. Doveclub representative, En. Naseem continued to make subsequent visits and contributions to the late En Jaafar's family.

On the 24 th August 2004, representatives of Doveclub made a visit to Marang, Terengganu to send a further contribution of RM500, school uniforms, Hari Raya clothes, foodstuff such as milk powder and Milo, diapers and other essentials to his family. In the month of July '05 recently, Doveclub representatives paid another visit to send some foodstuff to his family.

En. Jamadil Bin Jusoh is a contract driver attached with Dovechem Transport S/B. He has served the company for 2 years beginning 28 th June 2003.

He is married and was recently blessed with a child on the 17 th July 2005. Unfortunately, at 10am on the 9 th June 2005, fire broke out and destroyed his entire house as well as all of his belongings. Damages caused by the fire was estimated to be RM45,000.

The Dovechem Staff came to his aid with a contribution of RM284.00 and the Company contributed another RM1,000 to ease him in this particular time of need.

PBA Dialysis Centre

On the 26th July 2005, representatives of Dovechem Kuantan and Doveclub which consisted of Dato' KS Ng, En Naseem, Mr TO Chiar, Mr Nyit Fatt, En. Mohd Nasir, En Adanan, Ms Sharon and Ms Yeo paid a visit to the PBA Dialysis Center off Jalan Wong Ah Jang, Kuantan. Dovechem Kuantan together with Doveclub donated RM3,000 to the Center.

The PBA Dialysis Center representatives, Mr Kam and Mdm Ho gave brief explanation on the dialysis process. The center is equipped with about 9 dialysis machines, which caters for their 35 patients. A majority of the machines were contributed by the society.

Each patient is required to undergo dialysis treatment at least 3 times in a week. The cost incurred by patients would vary depending on their financial background. Approval must be obtained from HTAA before the patient is allowed to seek treatment at the center. The cost incurred by each patient could be as low as RM5 or RM60 for each treatment.
